SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saturday, 21 April - St Anselm, Bishop and Doctor of the Church

Saint Anselm is one of the most significant figures in Church history, a forerunner of medieval thought. Born in northern Italy, Anselm became a Benedictine and an outstanding teacher of theology at his monastery in France. In 1093, he was sent to England to become Archbishop of Canterbury. For his defense of the rights of the Church against the king, Anselm twice suffered exile. His writings had great influence and are still read today.
