CATHOLIC TEACHING ON CREMATION

The Catholic Church, since the second Vatican Council, (1962-1965) allows cremation. The Church teaches that the body and soul of each person is sacred. After the celebration of a Funeral Mass or a Prayer Service a deceased person is either buried or cremated. The Church teaches that, after a cremation, the ashes of the deceased must, at the appropriate time, be buried in a cemetery or interred in a cemetery wall or in a mausoleum. The ashes must not be sprinkled or placed in a home. This is because we believe in the resurrection of the dead. Our bodies and our souls will be reunited on the last day. **Fr Peter**
