FEAST OF THE WEEK

Thursday, 18 July – St. Frederick of Utrecht

Frederick I was Bishop of Utrecht between 815/816 and 834/838 AD, and is a saint of the Eastern Orthodox Church and Roman Catholic Church. Frederick was born around 780 in Friesland and was a grandson of the Frisian King Radboud. According to Church records, he died on 18 July 838. At a young age he was taught at Utrecht by the clergy, including Bishop Ricfried. After the death of Ricfried in 815/816, Frederick was chosen as Bishop of Utrecht. It is unclear exactly how Frederick came to an end. It has been established that he was murdered. Legend tells that he was stabbed by two men after the offering of the Mass on 18 July 838. Shortly after his death, Frederick was canonized. His feast day is 18 July and he is the patron saint of the deaf. He was buried in St. Salvator's Church in Utrecht.
