OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY

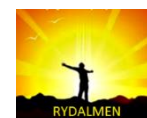
Mass will be celebrated on Monday, 7th October at 9.15am to honour the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. The month of October is dedicated to Our Lady.
