## MARIAN MONTH

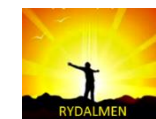
October is the month of our Lady. I encourage all parishioners to pray the Rosary daily and to ask our Blessed Mother's intercession.

## EAST OF THE WEEK

### Monday, 14 October – St. Callistus I

Callistus seems to have been a slave in the Trastevere area of Rome whose earliest years seemed quite unpromising. Having defrauded his master, who forgave him, he went on to set up his own moneylending business. But when in eager pursuit of a Jewish client, he disturbed the rites of a Jewish Synagogue, he was arrested, convicted and exiled to the salt mines of Sardinia. On his return he worked for some time with the Christian community at Anzio. By this time, however, he seems to have turned into quite a competent person. Pope Zephyrinus (119-217) brought him to Rome, ordained him and made him his administrator and advisor. Callistus was himself elected pope in 217, but a minority followed the more rigorist Hippolytus as anti-pope, thus making Callistus's papacy (217-222) quite a controversial time. Pope Callistus is listed as a martyr however no record of how he was martyred or by whom.
