of Rome whose earliest years seemed quite unpromising. Having defrauded his master, who forgave him, he went on PARISH COORDINATOR of MINISTRIES (PCM) - 21 to set up his own moneylending business. But when in eager pursuit of a Jewish client, he disturbed the rites of a Jewish Synagogue, he was arrested, convicted and exiled to the salt mines of Sardinia. On his return he worked for some time with the Christian community at Anzio. By this time, however, he seems to have turned into guite a competent person. Pope Zephyrinus (119-217) brought him to Rome, ordained him and made him his administrator and advisor. Callistus was himself elected pope in 217, but a **MISSION COORDINATOR (PART-TIME) - SISTERS OF** minority followed the more rigorist Hippolytus as anti-pope, **MERCY PARRAMATTA** thus making Callistus's papacy (217-222) quite a controversial time.
