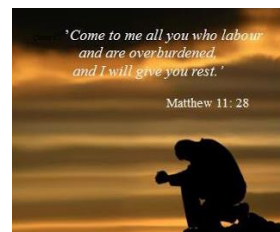

### FEAST OF THE WEEK

**Tuesday, 7 July – Bl. Peter To Rot**

Peter To Rot was born in 1912 in Rakunai, a village near Rabaul, the capital of New Britain, Papua New Guinea. When Peter was 18, the parish priest, Fr. Laufer, MSC, spoke to his father about the possibility of Peter becoming a priest. His father responded that it was not yet time for one of their generation to become a priest. However he agreed that Peter could become a catechist. His work was teaching in the parish school also visited and prayed with the sick. During Japanese occupation, village leaders were called and commanded: "You people must not pray to your God. You cannot meet on Sundays for service, and you must not pray in the villages either. Anyone who disobeys this law will go to jail." Peter was arrested and murdered in 1945.
