Peter To Rot was born in 1912 in Rakunai, a village near Rabaul, the capital of New Britain, Papua New Guinea. When Peter was 18, the parish priest, Fr. Laufer, MSC, spoke to his father about the possibility of Peter becoming a priest. His father responded that it was not yet time for one of their generation to become a priest.
