### FEAST OF THE WEEK

#### Friday, 31 July – St. Ignatius of Loyola

St. Ignatius of Loyola came from a family of minor nobility in Spain's northern Basque region. He was far from saintly during much of his young adult life. He was vain, with dreams of personal honour and fame. He gambled and was not above sword fighting. All that began to change one day in the spring of 1521. Ignatius was 30 years old, an officer in the Spanish army. Leading his fellow soldiers into a battle against the French, he was struck by a cannonball in the leg. During a difficult recovery, he read a book about the life of Christ and biographies of the saints — which he found unexpectedly riveting. These experiences would prove to be the beginnings of Ignatian spirituality — and Jesuit ministry. Together they made religious vows in 1534 and came to call themselves the Compañia de Jesús — the Society of Jesus. He died in 1556.
