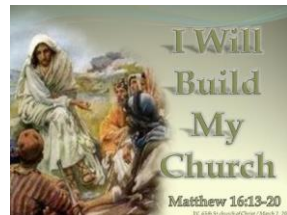

COVID-19 UPDATE

Parishioners attending the church are required to complete their details on the **Mass Attendance Sheet** provided at the back of the church. Currently up to 100 people can attend a place of worship. First come first serve is applied in this church.

On consideration of the most recent NSW Health advice, the Diocese of Parramatta **highly recommends** all worshippers at Masses in the Diocese to wear a mask to, during and from Mass and other services.

Please sanitise your hands.

Social distancing (1.5m) must be observed at all times. Take a seat only on unmarked pews.

If you are experiencing cold or flu-like symptoms, having a temperature or have been in contact with anyone that is either a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19, you should not enter the church.

During this pandemic you are dispensed from Sunday Mass obligations.

Baptisms

Currently baptisms are held on the **second and fourth Sunday** of the month and will take place with no more than **two** families at any time.

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

People wearing face masks receiving Holy Communion must remove their mask and consume the Host in front of the Priest or Minister. Do not walk away and then consume the Host. The Sacred Host is the Body of Christ.
