#### CATHOLICCARE IS STILL OPEN AND OPERATIONAL



#### **FEAST OF THE WEEK** Wednesday, 23 September - St Padre Pio

Padre Pio (25 May 1887 - 23 September 1968), was an Italian friar, priest, stigmatist and mystic. Born Francesco Forgione, he was given the name of Pius (Italian: Pio) when he joined the Order of Friars Minor Capuchin. In 1947, Fr. Karol Wojtyla visited Padre Pio who prophetically told him he would rise to the highest post in the Church." Fr. Karol Wojtyla became Pope John Paul II in 1978. Padre Pio became famous for exhibiting stigmata for most of his life, thereby generating much interest and controversy. He was known for his piety, charity and the quality of his preaching. He was both beatified (1999) and canonized (2002) by Pope John Paul II.
