Parishioners attending the church are required to complete their details on the **Mass Attendance Sheet** provided at the back of the church. Currently up to 300 people can attend a place of worship. First come first serve is applied in this church.

On consideration of the most recent NSW Health advice, the Diocese of Parramatta **highly recommends** all worshippers at Masses in the Diocese to wear a mask to, during and from Mass and other services.

Please sanitise your hands.

Social distancing (1.5m) must be observed at all times. Take a seat only on unmarked pews.

If you are experiencing cold or flu-like symptoms, having a temperature or have been in contact with anyone that is either a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19, you should not enter the church.

During this pandemic you are dispensed from Sunday Mass obligations.

Currently baptisms are held on the **second and fourth Sunday** of the month and will take place with no more than **two** families at any time.

November is a special time to pray for the dead. A plenary indulgence may be gained for the dead, by visiting a church on 2<sup>nd</sup> November and praying the Lord's prayer and the Creed. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic the Plenary indulgence can be obtained on any other day of the month chosen by each member of the faithful by praying the Our Father and the Creed. Three conditions are required for gaining the indulgence: Sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion and prayer for the Pope's intentions.
