FEAST OF THE WEEK

Monday, 19 October – St. Isaac Jogues

St. Isaac Jogues, S.J. (10 January 1607 – 18 October 1646) was a missionary and martyr who travelled and worked among the Iroquois, Huron, and other Native populations in North America. He was the first European to name Lake George, calling it Lac du Saint Sacrement (Lake of the Blessed Sacrament). In 1646, Jogues was martyred by the Mohawk at their village of Ossernenon, north of the Mohawk River. Jogues, Jean de Brébeuf and six other martyred missionaries, all Jesuit priests or laymen associated with them, were canonized by the Catholic Church in 1930; they are known as "The North American Martyrs". A shrine was built in their honour at Auriesville, New York, at a site formerly believed to be that of the Mohawk village.
