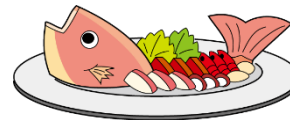
Catholic Women's League meeting will be held in the meeting room on Wednesday 15th May after morning mass. All are welcome.
